myKU PORTAL

The myKU portal is a central hub for information at KU. Use the myKU portal to access services such as Enroll & Pay, academic resources, parking permits and much more. Log in to the myKU portal at my.ku.edu.

ACCESSING KU EMAIL

Your KU email account is the official communication channel for important information from the University. You can check your email online at mail.ku.edu or through a variety of mobile devices and email clients. For configuration instructions and more information, visit email.ku.edu.

MyIDENTITY SERVICES

Visit myidentity.ku.edu to change your password, set up challenge questions for recovering a forgotten password and create up to three personal email aliases.

BLACKBOARD

Blackboard is KU's learning management system. Many instructors use Blackboard to organize and distribute course materials. Go to blackboard.ku.edu to learn more about using this resource. Also, the Blackboard mobile app is great for getting announcements and alerts when grades post. Log in to Blackboard at courseware.ku.edu to review and submit assignments and take tests. The app is available at mobileplaza.ku.edu.

WIRELESS ACCESS

Free access to the secure JAYHAWK wireless network is available in most campus locations, including academic and administrative buildings, libraries, student unions and outdoors. For a complete map and connection instructions, visit wireless.ku.edu.

SOFTWARE AT KU

Before you purchase software anywhere else, visit software.ku.edu to see what free and discounted software is available to students, as well as a list of software available in campus computer labs.

MICROSOFT OFFICE 365 - Students have free access to Office 365 at mycommunity.ku.edu. There they can download Office programs, including Word, Excel, PowerPoint and OneNote, to their personal devices.

PERSONAL FILE STORAGE

Students have 1TB of free personal file storage space via Microsoft's OneDrive for Business. Students can share files on OneDrive for Business with others at KU and external contacts. OneDrive for Business is integrated with Office 365 for editing and co-authoring documents. Access OneDrive for Business and more at mycommunity.ku.edu.
